Gentlemen:

During the casing leak survey of the Lovington field in June 1957 Mr. E. Engbrecht of the Hobbs OCC office found the following condition existed at subject well:

| <u>ANNULUS</u>  | <u>PRESSURE, psig.</u> |
|-----------------|------------------------|
| 13" x 8 5/8"    | 72                     |
| 8 5/8" x 5 1/2" | 50                     |
| 5 1/2" x 2"     | 45                     |
| 2"              | 25                     |

The 5 1/2" x 8 5/8" annulus blew down to a steady flow in 15 minutes and during this time the 8 5/8" x 13" annulus decreased in the same time interval. The OCC, therefore, must assume that a leak exists in the 8 5/8" casing.

You are hereby directed to contact the Commission office in Hobbs to outline a program (C-102) for further testing or remedial work to correct this situation.
