DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On February 25th at 3:30 PM, 65 hours had elapsed since setting 1980 feet of 8-5/8" OD 32# SH seamless casing and cementing with 600 sacks. Casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 750# was built up and held for thirty minutes, after which the cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 750# again built up and held for thirty minutes. As both of the above tests indicated that casing shut-off was OK, drilling operations was resumed.
