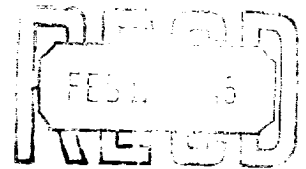

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On February 15th at 10:00 AM, 48 hours had elapsed since setting 281' of 13" OD 50# new casing as surface string and cemented with 250 sacks. Casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 750# was built up and held for thirty minutes, and casing shut-off tested OK. The cement plug was then drilled and a pressure of 750# again built up. As this test, too, was OK, drilling operations were resumed.
