DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 4:30 PM, May 12, 1945, 48 hours had elapsed since setting 4717 feet of new 5½" OD 14# Smls. casing and cementing with 400 sacks to be used for oil string. Casing shut-off was tested as follows:

A pressure of 750# was built up and held for thirty minutes and as casing shut-off tested OK, cement plug was drilled and a pressure of 750# again built up and held for thirty minutes. As this test, too, was OK, drilling operations was resumed.
