At 7:00 p.m. April 22, 1945 72 hours will have elapsed since setting 1986' of 8-5/8" OD 32# LW SE Casing and cementing with 600 sacks to be used as intermediate string. At this time we plan to test casing shut off as follows:

Build up pressure of 1000# and hold for 30 minutes and if shut off tests ok, cement plug will be drilled and a pressure of 1000# again built up and held for 30 minutes. If this test, too, is OK, drilling operations will be resumed.
