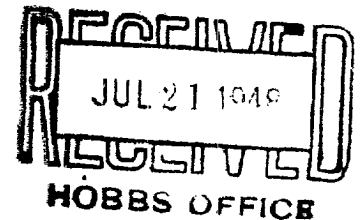

5½" Casing cemented at 4747 with 450 sacks.

Well was drilled to total depth 5120. Ran 2" EUE tubing to 5118' with packer set @ 4742. Swabbed well down. Tested 4 hours, 1 bbl oil per hour. Acidized, 7-10-48 with 2500 gals (chemical process) 15% acid, 4747-5120. Swabbed well down. Tested 2 bbls oil per hour for 4 hours. Reacidized, 7-11-48, with 6000 gals (chemical process).
