DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The well was treated with 1000 gallons of acid from 4720-4760 and from 4800'-4820'. Reaction time was 3 hours and 45 minutes. Casing pressures were 900# to 450#. Tubing pressures were 800# to 400#. After acid, the well flowed for 12 hours on March 23, 1945, making 20 bbls. pipe line oil per hour. On March 25, 1945 the well swabbed and flowed for 10 hours at the rate of 10 bbls. pipe line oil per hour. Well would not continue to flow without swabbing.
