## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Acidized well with 1000 gallons of Western Acid from 5000-5085'. Maximum and minimum pressures were 2100# and 1600#. Reaction time was 38 minutes. Well was swabbed for three hours after which it started flowing. Flowed well 9 hours and it cleaned up to Pipe Line Oil. The last hour well made 35 bbls PLO while cleaning up through open 2" tubing. Made 10bbls oil per hour while flowing through 17/64" choke into stock tanks.
