DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 5:30 p.m. on March 21, 1952, 30 hours had elapsed since running 4874' of new 8-5/8" casing landed at 4888' and cemented in two stages. Staging collar was set at 2200' and 1st stage cemented with 400 sacks 8% gel plus 100 sacks neat. 2nd stage was cemented through DV tool with 100 sacks neat. Casing shut off was tested above staging tool with 1050 psi for 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. Plug was drilled at 2200' and casing shut off was tested with 1100 psi for 30 minutes. Since there was no drop in pressure, test was considered satisfactory and drilling operations were resumed.
