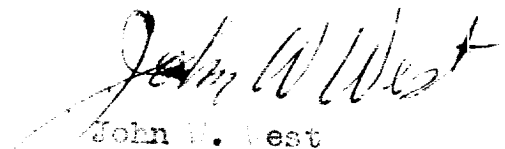
January 26, 1952, a survey was made to locate your State K Lease, Well No. 1, in the NE₄SE₄ Sec. 11, Twp. 17 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., at a point 660.0 feet from the east and 1980.0 feet from the south lines of the said section 11.

The U.S.G.L.O. stone markers were in place and marked at the quarter corner east, south and west from the southeast corner of section 11, and the section corner one mile south was also in place and properly marked. By projecting the line north from the two markers to the south we hit the west edge of a large pile of rocks at the southeast corner of section 11. Then by setting over this point and sighting on the marker to the east, we turned the angle 171°53' to the west and hit on the corner to the west which verified our point in the pile of rocks. This point was marked with a steel rod for future use.

From the southeast corner of section 11, we chained N0°1'W 1980.0 feet, thence 189°53'W 660.0 feet to the location. Before we chained to the location we chained a total of 8840.0 feet from the southeast corner and found we were 6 feet short and 14 inches off line from a stone that had the proper markings but was not in place. After we had chained to the location we turned 45° to the north-east and checked in on the lath we had set for the E corner.

I hereby certify that the foregoing survey was made in the field by me and that the same is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
