N.M.P.M., Oil Field Loc. County.

DETAILS

State names of and expected depths to objective sands or producing horizon; show sizes, weights, and lengths of casing run or proposed; indicating mudding jobs, cementing points, water horizon, number of days operated, and total depth at end of month, and other important information.

Filled hole with heavy mud and set 5 sacks cement at 4950 feet. Filled hole to top with heavy mud and set 5 sacks cement at 40 feet to protect surface water. Used 6" pipe as marker in cement and this marker extended over 4 ft from the surface of the ground.

There was 106 feet of 8 1/4" pipe left in hole. There was 1428 feet of 10" left in the hole and 166 feet of 15 1/2" pipe left in hole.
