NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

Dear Sir:

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon ~~Western-Republic State~~ Well No. 1 in ~~NE SE~~ of Sec. 13 Twp. 17 S, Rge. 36 E, N. M. P. M., _____ Oil Field, Lea County. We plan to commence work on January 25th, 1933.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

Drilled to 5216 feet, which is considered test in this area. Well is a dry hole.

The present condition of the well is as follows:

212'	-	15½"	Casing in hole
1888'7"	-	10"	" " "
3490'8"	-	8½"	" " "

Depth 5216 feet. About 3000 feet water in hole.

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

Will fill hole with heavy mud to 4950 and set 5 sacks cement. After pulling casing will fill hole with heavy mud. Surface water is cemented and cased off with 15½" casing. The casing at this water point will be left in hole.
