This well was spudded on July 13, 1962. A 17½" hole was drilled to 305'. 13-3/8, 48# J-55 casing was set at 304' using 300 sacks 1-1 dimix with 2% gel. Cement circulated. casing was pressure tested to 700psi for 30 min prior to drilling out after waiting on cement 22 hours. Casing tested OK.
