DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On October 11, we ran 2172' of 8-5/8" - 24# 8 Rnd thread J-55 Seamless casing and cemented with 100 sax by Halliburton. 50 sax of cement was pumped out the shoe and then casing was set down and 1" pipe was run on the outside of the 8-5/8" and 50 sax circulated to the surface. After allowing the cement to set 72 hours the plug was drilled and no water appeared in the hole. Drilling was resumed.
