DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On March 27, 1955, bullet perforated casing from 6214' to 6231' and from 6242' to 6274' with 4 shots per foot using Schlumberger No-Burr bullets. Ran in hole with Lynes Straddle Packer and set bottom packing element at 6238'. Then acidized section from 6242' to 6274' with 3000 gallons of 15% low tension acid. Flushed with 25 barrels of oil. Swabbed approximately 100 barrels of fluid from hole in 11 hours through casing and was unable to drain any free water from tank. On March 28, 1955, opened tool to zone from 6214' to 6231' and acidized with 2000 gallons of 15% special low tension acid. Flushed with 24.57 barrels of oil. Started swabbing well and swabbed 61.54 barrels of oil and 33 barrels of water in 10 hours through casing. All acidizing done by The Western Company.

No swab test was taken before well was acidized.
