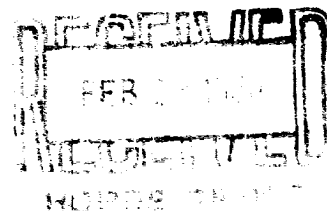

Run 4664' of 5½" OD, 17# casing, using Baker Floating Equipment, and cemented with 300 sacks mixed with 8% Howeogel and 100 sacks common cement. Allowed cement to sit 56 hours before drilling plug. Tested casing and cement with 900# pressure before and after drilling plug.
