

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Plan to pull the casing and plug the above described well on or about Oct. 15, 1939. Will bridge in the bottom of the 5 1/2" casing and cement with (5) five sacks of cement. Bridge in the bottom of the 8 5/8" casing at 3154 feet and cement a plug of (10) sacks cement. Bridge in the bottom of the 13" casing at 290 feet and cement to the surface and erect a marker.

Will shoot the casing strings off at the top of the cement used in setting the pipe.
