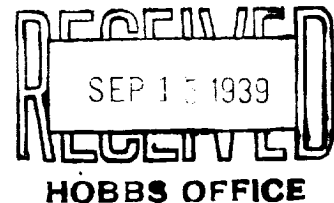

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At 11:00 AM September 15th, 72 hours will have elapsed since setting 5½" casing at 4567' with 175 sacks cement. At this time we plan to test shutoff in the following manner:

Build up pressure to 1000#, close valves and hold for 30 minutes. Drill plug, build up 1000# pressure, close valves and hold for 30 minutes. If test is O.K., drilling will be resumed.
