Houston, Inc., as you know, lost a string of logging tools in Lovington Paddock Unit #54.

Logging Tools lost:

1 - Rope Socket	1' in length
3 - Sinker Bars	15' in length
1 - Ejector	1.5' in length
1 - CCL	1' in length
1 - G/R Detector	5' in length
1 - Temperature Tool	2' in length

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25.5' TOTAL LENGTH

Logging tools lost were 1 3/8" O.D., and an attempt to fish the tools was unsuccessful. The ejector contained approx. 1 MCI I-131 Liquid Radioactive Material with a half life of 8.4 days.

We would suggest leaving the tools, as it poses no threat to the environment.
