After allowing cement to set from April 22, to April 29, (reason for letting set this length of time - the well two locations to the north hit air-pocket and was blowing out and were waiting for air volume to blow down before drilling ahead) drilled plug and tested for casing shut-off in 9-5/8" OD casing set by Halliburton Process at depth of 2950' - casing shut-off tested OK - Now drilling ahead.
