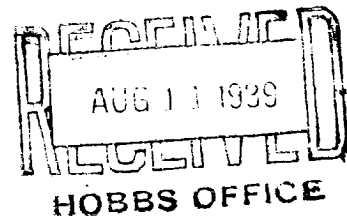

Drilled to 310' and ran and cemented 13" OD casing on bottom with 250 ~~sq~~ cement- Halliburton Process. Cement was circulated back into bottom of cellar. Will allow to stand 48 hrs and on August 10th at approximately 10:AM will drill plug and test for casing shut-off.
