Ran 5-1/2" casing as follows from bottom to top - 1403.76' of 17 lb. N-80, 1413.73' of 17 lb. J-55, 5158.661 of 15.5 lb. J-55 and 1036.85' of 17 lb. N-80. Baker whirler shoe on bottom, set at 9013' KB automatic fill-up insert in first collar. Cemented with 300 sacks Dowell 50% poz cement. Tested pipe to 2000 lb., held o.k., checked float, held o.k. Waited on cement for 7 days before rigging up completion rig.


