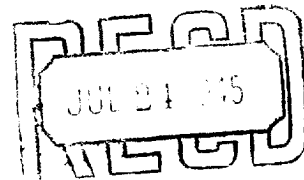

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

The hole was spudded on June 16, 1945. Size of the drilling bit was 15 1/2". The first water was encountered at 508' to 528' and tested 1/2 barrel per hour. It was not a fresh water. The 10 3/4" - 32.00# casing was landed at 547' and mudded with eight sacks of Aqua-Gel and 25 sacks of mud. After setting six hours the mud was bailed from the inside of the pipe to test for a water shutoff. No water was indicated. After drilling by the shoe the well was again shut down for a sufficient period of time to test for leaks around the shoe. Again no water was indicated. Drilling operations were then resumed.
