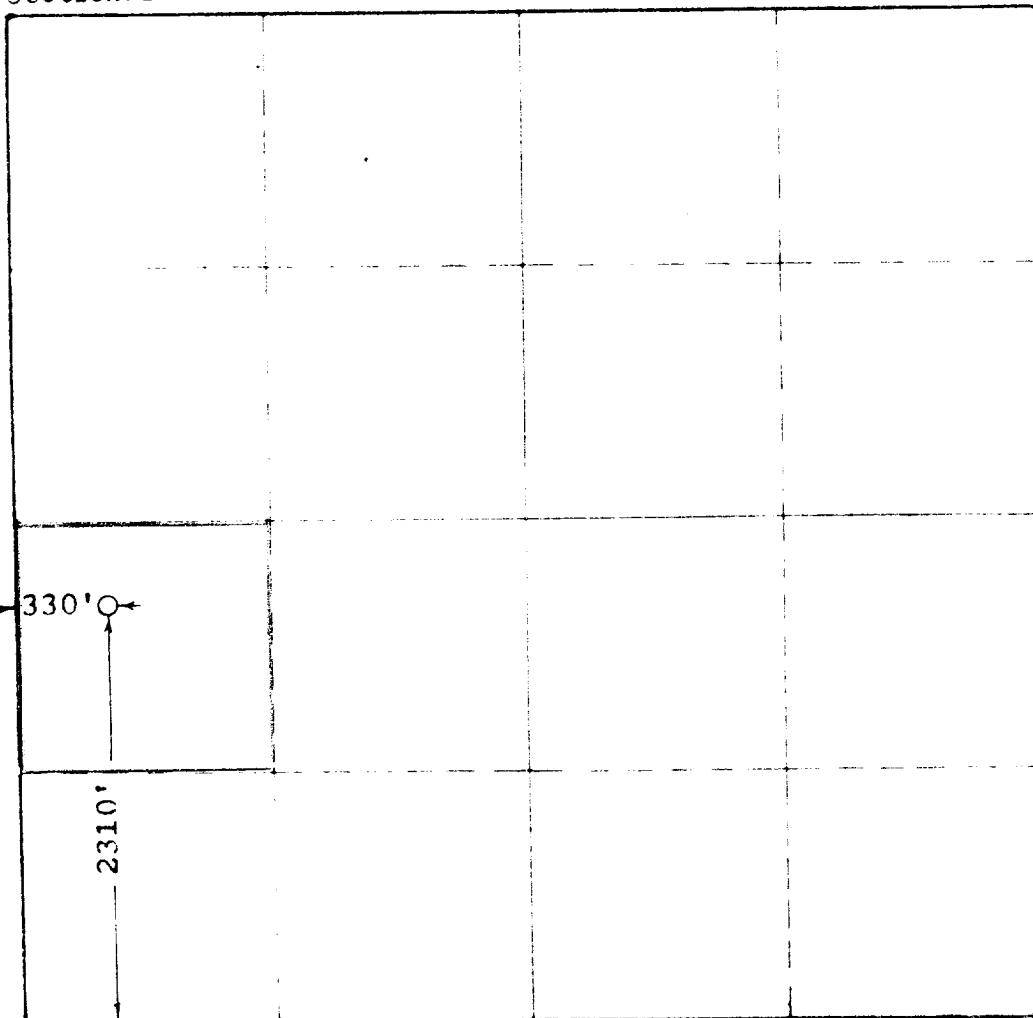

Gentlemen:

On Oct. 10, 1957 a survey was made to locate your State of New Mexico AP Well No. 1 located 2310 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the West line of Sec. 16, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

The Transit was set up at the USGLO Section corner marker common to Sections 16, 17, 8 and 9 and a flag was set on the Northwest corner marker to Sec. 9, thence chaining S0°02'E 2970 feet, (at 1980 feet we found wooden stake used for staking Gulf well), thence chaining S89°46'E 330 feet to the location. As a check we retraced our survey checking in with a minimum of error.
