Cur letter of September 11, 1957 requested certain information and forms on several of your wells, one of which was Form C-128 on your Young No. 10-I in Section 17, T-18-S, R-32-E, Young Oil Pool. On September 20, 1957 a corrected Form C-128 was filed and indicates that the well is located 1025 feet from the east line, and 2350 feet from the south line.

Commission Rules and Regulations set forth in Rule 104 that no well shall be drilled closer than 330 feet to any boundary line of a quarter quarter section. Any deviation from this requirement has to have approval after Notice and Hearing. Therefore effective September 24, 1957 the allowable is hereby cancelled until further notice.
