Gentlemen:

Receipt is acknowledged of your "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated December 4, 1955, covering your well No. 3 Young located in the NE 1/4, section 17, T. 18 N., R. 32 E., Young (Extension) Field, Lea County, New Mexico.

Your proposed work is hereby approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the "Oil and Gas Operating Regulations" revised May 25, 1952, a copy of which will be sent you on request and subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Drilling operations so authorized are subject to the attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
- (2) Notify this office in sufficient time to arrange for a representative to witness the cementing operations and water shut off tests.
- (3) Furnish this office with a sample description log from the base of the salt to the total depth, and/or copies of any electrical logs or surveys run, in addition to four copies of our log of oil or gas well, form G-330.
- (4) This approval to drill supersedes approval to drill said well dated October 31, 1955, changing the location from 1900 feet from the north and west lines of section 17 to 1650 feet from south and 2310 feet from east lines of section 17.
