FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We propose to acidize zone from 4860-4878, with 500 gallons; and then reacidize with 1500 gallons, using Sweet formation packer at 4834; to swab and test this zone.

We then propose to pull tubing, reset the Sweet formation packer at 4700, and acidize the zone from 4625 to 4700, using 6000 gallons; to swab and test this zone.
