DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 4678 Lime. Loaded hole with 145 bbls. oil & introduced 2000 gal. Dowell XXWF-6. Flushed tubing with 18 bbls. oil. Pumped 20 bbls. oil down casing to insure holding acid down. Swabbed 12 times to 3500' & recovered 100 bbls. oil load & acid and well started flowing. Flowed 180 bbls. oil, oil load & acid in 7 hours. Next 8 hours well flowed 198 bbls. oil, no water in 8 hours. Gas measured 300 MCF daily. Gas-oil ratio 505. Well shut in after above test to connect for regular production.
