DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4678 Lime. Loaded hole with 140 bbls. oil & introduced 1000 gal. Dowell XXWF-6. Flushed tubing with 18 bbls. oil. After swabbing out oil load & acid well started flowing. In 7 hours flowed 131 bbls. oil, no water. Gas measured 222 MCF daily. Gas-oil ratio 494. On 12 hours test thru 3/4" choke on 2" tubing well flowed 231 bbls. oil, no water. Gas measured 232.5 MCF daily. Gas-oil ratio 503. Well was then shut in to prepare for another acid treatment.
