

Gentlemen:

Attached is Texaco's Application for Triple Completion for the State of New Mexico "O" (NCT-1) Well No. 14, located 2086 feet from the east line and 1874 feet from the south line, Unit J, Section 36, T-17-S, R-34-E, Lea County, New Mexico. TEXACO Inc. plans to complete this well as a triple oil completion in the Undesignated (Devonian, Wolfcamp, and Abo) Pools. It is anticipated that all zones will be oil completions and will flow initially. Approval has been granted previously by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for these zones in another well in this area. Reference Mobil Oil Company's State Bridges Well No. 95, quadruple completion authorized by Order No. R-2372. The Devonian interval will be conventionally completed through a string of 4-1/2 inch casing and the Wolfcamp and Abo intervals will be tubingless completions through parallel strings of 2-7/8 inch casing.

Also attached is a copy of the plat showing the area immediately surrounding Texaco's State of New Mexico "O" (NCT-1) Lease and a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed triple completion. It is respectfully requested that TEXACO Inc. be granted administrative approval for this application as provided for under Rule 112-A.

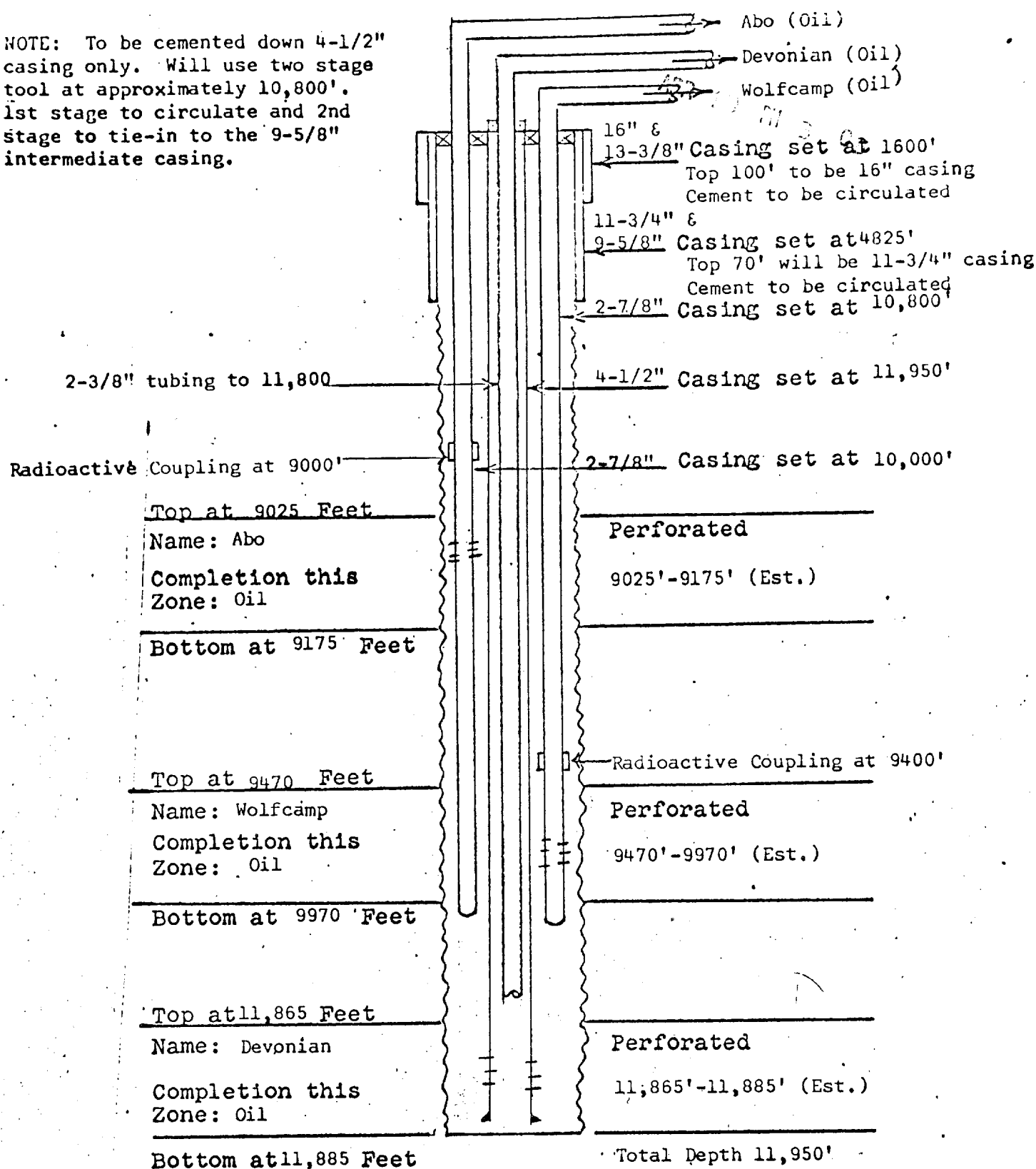

DIAGRAMMATIC SKETCH OF TRIPLE COMPLETION INSTALLATION (TUBINGLESS)

NOTE: To be cemented down 4-1/2" casing only. Will use two stage tool at approximately 10,800'. 1st stage to circulate and 2nd stage to tie-in to the 9-5/8" intermediate casing.
