

Gentlemen:

Attached is TEXACO's Application for Triple Completion for the State of New Mexico "O" (NCT-1) Well No. 17, located 760 feet from the south line and 2080 feet from the west line, Unit N, Section 36, T-17-S, R-34-E, Lea County, New Mexico. TEXACO plans to complete this well as a triple oil completion in the Undesignated (Devonian, Pennsylvanian and Wolfcamp) Pools. It is anticipated that all zones will be oil completions and will flow initially. Approval has been granted previously by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for these zones in TEXACO's State of New Mexico "O" (NCT-1) Well No. 11 by Order No. MC-1265. The Devonian will be conventionally completed through 4-1/2 inch casing and the Wolfcamp and Pennsylvanian will be tubingless completions through parallel strings of 2-7/8" casing.

Also attached is a copy of the plat showing the area immediately surrounding TEXACO's State of New Mexico "O" (NCT-1) Lease and a diagrammatic sketch of the proposed triple completion. It is respectfully requested that TEXACO Inc. be granted administrative approval for this application as provided for under Rule 112-A.

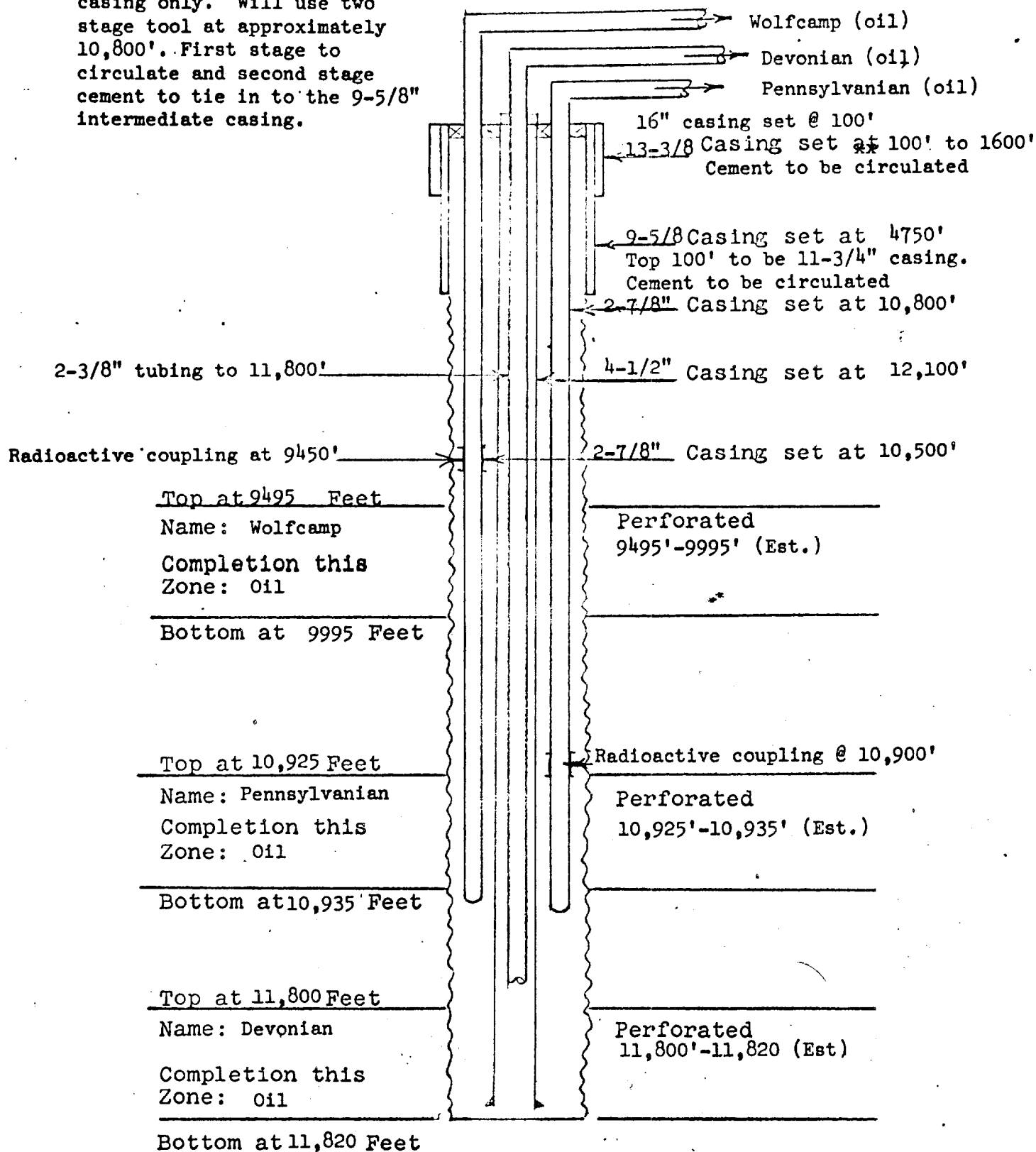

\* Should waivers from all offset operators not accompany an application for administrative approval, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission will hold the application for a period of twenty (20) days from date of receipt by the Commission's Santa Fe office. If, after said twenty-day period, no protest nor request for hearing is received by the Santa Fe office, the application will then be processed.

NOTE: If the proposed multiple completion will result in an unorthodox well location and/or a non-standard perforation unit in either or both of the producing zones, then separate application for approval of the same should be filed simultaneously with this application.
