Gentlemen:

Your Notice of Intention to Drill well No. 1 Federal 19 (copy attached) in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 19, T. 19 S., R. 33 E., N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, lease New Mexico 077004, to a depth of 3,500 feet to test the Yates-Seven Rivers formations, has been forwarded to this office for approval.

Pursuant to authority delegated to the Regional Oil and Gas Supervisor on May 10, 1962, 27 F. R. 4814, I hereby approve the Notice of Intention to Drill described in the foregoing.

Please furnish the District Engineer, Geological Survey, P. O. Box 1157, Hobbs, New Mexico, a daily drilling progress report in duplicate from spud date until completion of the well, and notify that office in sufficient time for a representative to witness all cementing operations.

If the lease is to be considered for extension by diligent drilling operations, the lease rental must be timely paid.
