DETAILS OF WORK

It is proposed to drill down with cable tools to an approximate depth of 3500 feet to test the Yates-McKen Rivers formations. Approximately 75 feet of 13-3/8" casing will be cemented to the surface. Approximately 700' of 10" casing and 900' of 8-5/8" casing will be mudded. We will set 5 1/2" casing at total depth and bring cement back to the anhydrite above the salt. Completion will be made through perforations.
