The above well was shutin and temporarily abandoned on January 18th, as advised in our C-103 form dated January 24, 1972 and approved by Mr. Joe Ramey, District I Supervisor for the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

The well was shutin because Mr. Tom Ingram, by farmout from Featherstone Development Corporation, had drilled and completed his TP #2 on the same 40-acre tract and only 330' North of our TPC&O State #1. Both wells are producing from the ABO at about 8800'.

Mr. Ingram's well is producing less than the allowable (less than 100 BOPD). We intend to commence producing our well and will submit the results of our GOR on from C-116 which will be taken next week.
