Dear Mr. Walker:

O In compliance with the last paragraph of letter dated June 15, 1964,  
from the Gulf Oil Corporation to your office, the progress report of the  
Charles B. Read #1 Gulf State,  $SW\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 12-17S-36E, Lea County,  
New Mexico, is as follows:

P DST#3 was run from 9005' to 9052', open 2 hours, recovered 6446'  
of oil, 31.5 gravity, 160' slightly oil-and-gas-cut mud. DST #4 was run  
from 9005' to 9058', open 2 hours, 40 minutes, recovered 4675' oil, 100'  
slightly oil-and-gas-cut salty water. 4 1/2" casing was set at 9299' and  
cemented with 350 sacks cement. Casing was perforated from 9026'-28',  
9038'-41', 9049'-54', and treated with 500 gal. MSA acid and 1000 gal.  
MCA acid. Pumping equipment was installed on July 31, 1964, and test  
operations have been conducted for the past 13 days. Well is presently  
pumping 28 barrels of oil per day, no water.
