Gentlemen:

TEXACO Inc. respectfully requests that Administrative Order No. MC-1494 be amended to the effect to authorize the triple completion of State of New Mexico "O" (NCT-) Well No. 24, located in Unit P of Section 36, Township 17 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Vacuum Glorieta Pool, the Vacuum North Abo Pool, and the Vacuum Wolfcamp Pool through parallel strings of 2-7/8 inch casing cemented in a common well bore.

This request is made due to the fact that the Upper Pennsylvanian Pool was non-commercial and the Vacuum Glorieta Pool was completed in the respective 2-7/8 inch casing string in which the Upper Pennsylvanian Pool completion was attempted. The Glorieta, North Abo and Wolfcamp pools have previously been approved for a triply completed well in the Vacuum Field by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Phillips Petroleum Company Santa Fe Well No. 87.

Please find attached a revised diagrammatic sketch, bottom-hole pressure survey, electrical log survey and zone segregation test. A copy of this request is being sent to each offset operator.

MC-1452 be amended to the effect to authorize the triple completion of State of New Mexico "O" (NCT) Well No. 24, located in Unit 9 of Section 36, Township 17 North, Range 34 East, T17N, R34E, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Vacuum Glorieta Pool, the Vacuum North Abo Pool, and the Vacuum Wolfcamp Pool through parallel strings of 2-7/8 inch casing cemented in a common well bore.

This request is made due to the fact that the Upper Pennsylvanian Pool was non-commercial and the Vacuum Glorieta Pool was completed in the respective 2-7/8 inch casing string in which the Upper Pennsylvanian Pool completion was attempted. The Glorieta, North Abo and Wolfcamp pools have previously been approved for a triple completed well in the Vacuum Field by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Phillips Petroleum Company Santa Fe Well No. 87.
