This well was plugged and abandoned on October 28, 1964 at a total depth of 3175' in the following manner;

1. Ran 2-3/8" tubing to TD and set 35 sack cement plug from 3175 to 3075'.
2. Filled hole with 200 barrels of salt water gel mud.
3. Set 35 sack cement plug from 2850' to 2750'.
4. Set 52 sack cement plug from 1350' to 1200'.
5. Pulled 940' of 8-5/8" casing that was mudded @ 940'.
6. Pulled 495' of 10-3/4" casing that was mudded @ 495'.
7. Ran tubing and set 50 sack cement plug from 650' to 550'.
8. Set 20 sack cement plug from 25' to surface.

Dry hole marker will be erected and location ready for inspection by November 15, 1964.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.
