

Gentlemen:

In your letter of June 10, 1966, you requested a tabulation of the deviation surveys made while drilling the above captioned well. Carper Drilling Company was the contractor on this well.

Cities Service Oil Company bought the production, but not the rigs of the Carper Drilling Company. The records we got from Carper were for wholly owned, or joint interest producing properties. If we picked up any records on wells that Carper drilled as a contractor, they have since been destroyed.

After a thorough search of our records, it is apparent that we can be of no help to you in this matter.
