Dear Sir:

On July 23rd we requested a Commingling Permit on the above well for the Upper Penn. Zone which would permit this well to be produced into State Bridges #95 Battery located in Unit A & B, Sec. 26, T-17S, R-34E. The State Land Board in Santa Fe has requested us not to commingle the oil produced from the Upper Penn. Zone from the above well.

We have installed two 1000 barrel storage tanks at Battery #95 to isolate the oil produced from the Upper Penn. Zone from the other zones on the State Bridges lease.

At the present time we have an allowable of 177 barrels daily assigned to the above well for the Wolfcamp Zone. Due to the Upper Penn. Zone having a larger allowable and the Wolfcamp Zone not producing as anticipated, which requires additional testing, it is requested that the allowable on the Wolfcamp Zone be cancelled and an allowable be assigned to the Upper Penn. Zone effective August 1st.
