

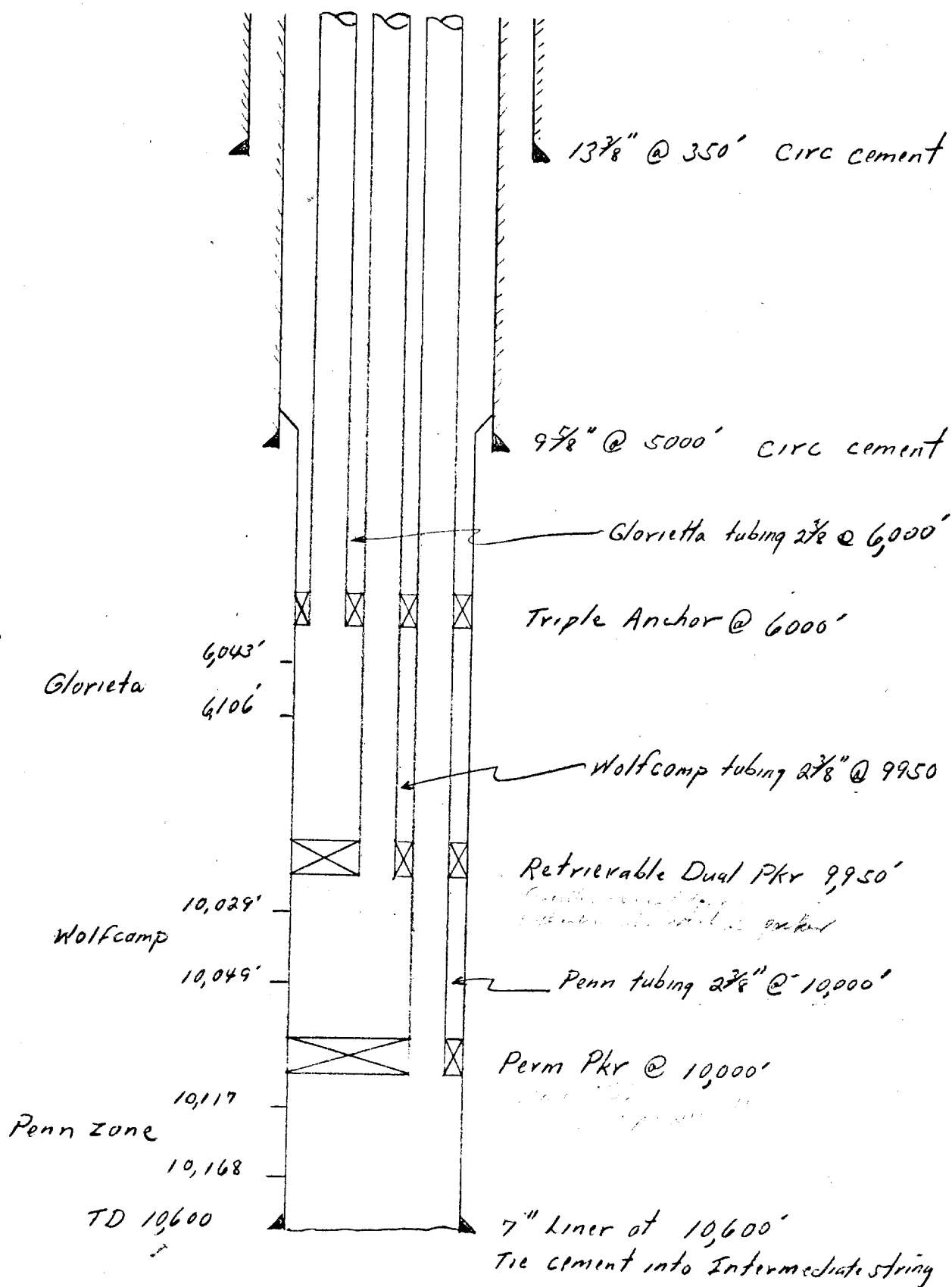

CORPORATION FOR A TRIPLE
COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1716

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Mobil Oil Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on May 31, 1966, for permission to triply complete its State Bridges Well No. 109 located in Unit N of Section 24, Township 17 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Vacuum-Glorieta Pool, the Vacuum-Wolfcamp Pool, and the Vacuum-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool.

Now, on this 10th day of June, 1966, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That waiver of objection has been received from the offset operator and the waiting period as prescribed by said rule may be dispensed with at this time.
- (4) That the proposed triple completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed triple completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Mobil Oil Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to triply complete its State Bridges Well No. 109 located in Unit N of Section 24, Township 17 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Vacuum-Glorieta Pool, the Vacuum-Wolfcamp Pool, and the Vacuum-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual GOR Test Period for the Vacuum-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
