Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to the local Federal and/or State office, are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

General:This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated on reverse side of form. It may also be used for submitting proposals for drilling or reworking wells on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly regarding submission of copies to the local Federal and/or State office, are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
