Confirming our telephone conversation this date between the undersigned and Mr. John Runyan, the following plugs will be spotted in P&A operations in subject well:

100' cement plug at TD, 11,860
100' at top of Penn, 10,940
550' from top of Wolfcamp, 9,645
(a DST of the Abo zone will be taken after setting above plug)
100' at top of Abo, 8,700
100' at top of Glorieta, 6,870
100' through shoe of 8-5/8" casing at 4,475

Attempts will be made to recover the maximum amount of 8-5/8" casing. Appropriate plugs will be spotted when it is determined the amount of 8-5/8 recovery obtained.

Plugging operations are planned to commence January 15, 1974.
