Dear Jerry:

The 60 day preliminary test period on the captioned well expires on October 9, 1976. To date with the exception of cleanup after acidizing, the well has been produced only 48 hours, for the NMOCC test we filed with your office. We are negotiating with Phillips for a casinghead gas connection, however we feel this will not be consummated for several months. In the interim period, we wish to perform a 30 day reservoir limits test toward possibly drilling an offset to the east on a State Lease. This testing period would exceed the 60 day period by approximately ten days.

Since gas has been flared only two days since completion and since an exception would be expedient toward maintaining a development drilling program on State Land to evaluate this newly discovered Cisco reservoir, it is requested that an exception be granted to complete the 30 day reservoir limit test or until November 1, 1976, whichever comes first.
