- 2. PLANNED ACCESS ROADS Cont'd
 - F. Culverts: None required.
 - G. Cuts and Fills: None required.
 - H. <u>Cattleguards</u>: No new guards will be required.

3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS:

A. There is a shallow producing well approximately 330' south in Section 26. There are numerous plugged & abandoned wells in a 2 mile radius of proposed well site.

4. LOCATION OF EXISTING AND/OR PROPOSED FACILITIES:

- A. Location of the proposed tank battery and flow line from well No. 1 are shown on Exhibit "D". There are no water disposal lines or injection lines.
- B. If the well is productive, the tank battery and flow line will be located on the well pad and no additional surface disturbance will occur.
- 5. LOCATION AND TYPE OF WATER SUPPLY:
 - A. Water will be purchased & trucked to well site over existing roads shown on Exhibit "A" & "B".

6. SOURCE OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS:

- A. Caliche for surfacing the well pad will be obtained from an existing pit approximately 3/4 miles east of drill site as shown on Exhibit "B".
- 7. METHODS OF HANDLING WASTE DISPOSAL:
 - A. Drill cuttings will be disposed of in the drilling pits.
 - B. Drilling fluids will be allowed to evaporate in the drilling pits until pits are dry.

C. Water produced during tests will be disposed of in the drilling pits. Oil produced during tests will be stored in test tanks until sold.
