8/ 3/84 Moved in frac tanks loaded with fresh water. Rigged up Halliburton. Mixed KCL and gelled water. Fraced well down 4 1/2" casing with 20,000 gal of gelled water and 43,000 lbs of 20-40 sand. Tested lines. Started frac. Maximum treating pressure: 2490 psi, average treating pressure: 2360 psi, average injection rate: 19.5 bpm. ISIP: 2150, 5 min: 2000, 10 min: 1930, 15 min: 1900, 30 min: 1840. Shut down. Left well shut in overnight to let gel break. 583 BLWTR

8/ 4/84 CP: 1275 psi, opened well on 10/64 choke at 7:00 AM. Flowed 2 1/2 hrs. Recovered 27 bbls load water. Increased choke to 14/64. Flowing CP: 840 psi. Left well open on 12/64 choke overnight.

8/ 5/84 CP: 30 psi, well nearly dead. Flowing by weak heads. Fluid recovered in 23 hrs (6:00 AM 8/ 5/84) was 85 bbls of load. 498 BLWTR. Left well open on 12/64 choke. Shut down.

8/ 6/84 CP: 0 psi, recovered 13 bbls fluid in last 24 hrs. Well dead. Total fluid recovered 8/ 6/84 @ 6:00 AM is 98 bbls, 100% water. 485 BLWTR. Rigged up to run tubing and swabbed. Swabbed well 7 1/2 hrs and recovered 77 BLW. No show of oil or gas. Well appears to be sanding up. Swabbing fluid level at 3000' FS. Total fluid recovered at 5:30 PM 8/ 6/84 is 175 bbls. 408 BLWTR. Shut down.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
