1. The geologic surface is quaternary.
2. The estimated geological marker tops:

Delaware	4619'

3. Estimated depths to water, oil or gas:

Water: 200'

Oil or Gas: 5300'

4. Proposed casing program:

5. Pressure Control Equipment: The blowout preventer will be a double ram type preventer. A sketch is attached.

6. Mud Program:

0 - 400': Native mud adding gel and lime for sufficient viscosity to insure clean hole for running casing.

400' - 5500': Drill out with native becoming brine at 4200' add starch and salt gel to maintain a viscosity of 32-38, mud weight 9.8 - 10.0, viscosity at T.D. 40.0.

7. Auxiliary Equipment: A kelly cock will be installed on the rig floor while drilling operations are in progress.
8. Testing, Logging and Coring Programs: Possible drillstem tests and/or coring is not planned.
Logging: Compensated Neutron - Formation Density - Gamma Ray - Caliper
- Dual Laterolog - RXO
9. No abnormal pressures or temperature zones are anticipated.
10. Anticipated starting date: Commence drilling operations ASAP.

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
