



The operator shall submit monthly progress reports of the project in accordance with Rules 706 and 1115 of the Division Rules and Regulations.

Water Production & disposal Information

In order to process your disposal request, the following information must be completed:

1. Name of formations producing water on the lease. Delaware
2. Amount of water produced from all formations in barrels per day. 20 bbls/day
3. **Attach a current water analysis of produced water from all zones showing at least the total dissolved solids, ph, and the concentrations of chlorides and sulfates. (one sample will suffice if the water is commingled)**
4. How water is stored on the lease. 300 bbl H₂O tank
5. How water is moved to the disposal facility. piped thru 2" poly to Geronimo Federal ~~W~~ via Gade Federa
6. Identify the **Disposal Facility** by :
 - A. Facility operators name. Sute Oil & Gas Corp.
 - B. Name of facility or well name & number. Geronimo Federal
 - C. Type of facility or well (WDW)(WIW) etc. WIW
 - D. Location by 1/4 1/4 SWNE section 24 township 18S range 31E
7. **Attach a copy of the State issued permit for the Disposal Facility.**
