***APPLICATION OF PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY TO EXPAND ITS PRESSURE  
MAINTENANCE PROJECT IN THE VACUUM GRAYBURG-SAN ANDRES POOL IN LEA  
COUNTY, NEW MEXICO***

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION**

Under the provisions of Division Order Nos. R-5897 and R-6856, Phillips Petroleum Company has made application to the Division on September 12, 1997 for permission to expand its East Vacuum Grayburg-San Andres Pressure Maintenance Project in the Vacuum Grayburg-San Andres Pool in Lea County, New Mexico.

**THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:**

- (1) The application has been filed in due form.
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified of the application.
- (3) No objection has been received within the waiting period as prescribed by Rule 701(B).
- (4) The proposed injection wells is eligible for conversion to injection under the terms of Rule 701.
- (5) The proposed expansion of the above referenced East Vacuum Grayburg-San Andres Pressure Maintenance Project will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (6) The application should be approved.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

The applicant, Phillips Petroleum Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to alternately inject water and CO<sub>2</sub> into the San Andres formation at approximately 4305 feet to approximately 4645 feet through 2 7/8-inch plastic lined tubing set in a packer at located within 100 feet of the uppermost depth of the injection interval in the following described wells for purposes of pressure maintenance to wit:
