Due to economic conditions at this time, Siete Oil and Gas Corporation respectfully requests permission to temporarily abandoned the above captioned well. The following procedure is how we proposed to do so.

- 1) MIRU Carl's Pump Jack Service & disassemble pumping unit and move to Gila Federal #1.
- 2) TOH w/rods & tbg, TIH w/BP & tbg, set BP to isolate producing interval, TOH w/tbg, move tbg & rods to Gila Federal #1.
- 3) Tear dn wellhead assembly, install tbg valve, close in all valves, pull fuses from electrical panel.

If oil market prices increase in the future to make it economically possible to produce this well, Siete Oil and Gas Corporation reserve the right to pull the BP & produce the Inca Federal #8.

This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

## SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS

Item 13—Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
