Dear Mr. Sexton:

As we discussed in our phone conversation this morning Mallon Oil Company would like to begin the downhole commingling of our Mobil "5" State #1 well. As detailed in our Application for Downhole Commingling of Oil Production, mailed September 4, 1990, the well is completed in the Blinebry and Lower San Andres zones. It is presently producing from the Lower San Andres alone.

Since September 4th we have perforated and acidized the additional portions of the Lower San Andres described in that letter. That additional work has resulted in substantially more water production then we previously had. After the first week of pumping, the well is producing around 6 BO and 60 BW from the Lower San Andres. The well treated "tight" throughout acidization and I anticipate that we would see a substantial drop in the total liquid rate in the next few weeks which should put the total water production from the well below the 50 BPD limit stipulated in the Rules & Regulations book for administrative approval.

We are requesting a 30 day period to commingle oil from the zones begining around 10/15/90 and will report back to you on the production rates toward the end of that period.
